W.A.S.H. (Wednesday After School Happenings) is a program for 2nd-12th grade students, hosted by Pleasant Hill Baptist Church (PHBC). Students who may not have a ride are invited to ride the church van/bus from their respective school on Wednesday afternoons. The W.A.S.H. program provides afternoon snacks, activities, dinner, & bible studies to participating students. It is the parent's responsibility to communicate to the student if they are to ride the PHBC van/bus from week to week. Bauxite Middle School nor Pleasant Hill Baptist Church are responsible for students (with this permission form on file) riding contrary to parental instructions.

The Pleasant Hill Baptist Church after school program pick-up begins Wednesday, September 6th and runs through December 13th (excluding Wed. Nov. 1st) for the Fall semester. Spring Semester pick-up will begin Wednesday January 10th.

The W.A.S.H. program begins at 3:30pm and concludes at 7:30pm on Wednesdays during the school year. Students may be picked up at Pleasant Hill Baptist Church (PHBC) or one of two of site van/bus drop off locations (Gaspar store on West Sardis Rd or Bauxite High School campus in front of Band bldg.) These drop off times range between 7:45 & 8:15pm.

As a participant in the W.A.S.H. program, students are expected to follow all instructions given by their leaders and conduct themselves with respectful attitudes, actions, and speech. Students may be disallowed from participating if these expectations are not met. Initial infractions will be addressed between the church leadership and the offending student. Parents will be contacted in the case of ongoing disciplinary problems and made aware of the situation before any final warning of expulsion is made. Ultimately, our is to not remove anyone from participation, but we must do what is best for the group and for the liability of PHBC. Students are, under no circumstances, permitted to leave the premises of PHBC without first notifying church leadership. This is not intended to inconvenience you, the parent, but to maintain student safety.
